

Exercise 3: Write 8th notes against the given bass line.

The exercise is written in 4/4 time. The bass line consists of 12 measures. The first three measures contain eighth notes: G₂, A₂, B₂; C₂, D₂, E₂; F₂, G₂, A₂. The next three measures contain eighth notes: B₂, C₂, D₂; E₂, F₂, G₂; A₂, B₂, C₂. The next three measures contain eighth notes: D₂, E₂, F₂; G₂, A₂, B₂; C₂, D₂, E₂. The final measure contains a whole note G₂. The treble staff is empty except for a treble clef and a 4/4 time signature.
